- Provide and maintain safe plant and equipment, and require contractors to similarly satisfy requirements ensure safe handling, use of substances, and safe disposal of any surplus or generated waste.
- Provide information, instruction and supervision for employees.
- Ensure all employees are competent to do their tasks, and source them adequate training as necessary and appropriate.
- Aim to prevent accidents and cases of work-related ill health.
- Maintain safe and healthy working conditions.
- Ensure that any deliberate breach of health and safety rules and procedures lead to disciplinary action; and review and revise this policy as necessary at regular intervals not exceeding 2 years.
- As Health and Safety Manager, I will set a good personal example to others in complying with duties laid upon me and will expect all employees to co-operate with the company in respect of this policy to ensure this it is carried out.
